GOVERNOR ABBOTT'S PLAN TO REOPEN TEXAS: PHASE 1 QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE FOR THE CITY OF CELINA

UPDATED 5/7/2020

Pursuant to Executive Orders GA-18 & GA-21, issued by Governor Greg Abbott, the establishments listed below may reopen in the City of Celina. In providing or obtaining essential services or reopened services, all persons (including individuals, businesses and other organizations, and any other legal entity) should use good-faith efforts and available resources to follow the minimum standard health protocols recommended by DSHS, found at www.dshs.texas.gov/coronavirus.

PHASE 2 OF GOVERNOR ABBOTT'S PLAN TO REOPEN TEXAS WILL BEGIN MAY 18, 2020 (THIS IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE UPON FURTHER STATE MANDATES)

COSMETOLOGY SERVICES

- Cosmetology Salons, Hair Salons, Nail Salons, Tanning Salons, and Barber Shops may open with restrictions on **Friday, May 8, 2020**
- Restrictions are as follows:
 - One customer per stylist and appropriate social distancing
 - Masks are recommended for both stylist and customers
 - Reservation systems are strongly recommended to avoid grouping of walk-ins in waiting areas

NO CHANGES WERE MADE TO HOW ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES OPERATE. EXECUTIVE ORDER GA-18 DOES NOT APPLY TO "ESSENTIAL" BUSINESSES THAT HAVE BEEN ABLE TO OPERATE DURING THE STAY-AT-HOME ORDER.

RETAIL STORES

- All retail stores may open - limited to 25% operating capacity including employees
- Retail To-Go options of online ordering, curbside pick-up and delivery are highly encouraged
- Consider having all employees wear cloth face coverings
- Consider having an employee manage and control access to store, including opening doors for customers
- Use contact-less payment options, if possible

THE FOLLOWING ESTABLISHMENTS WILL REMAIN CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE:

BARS - GYMS - PUBLIC PLAYGROUNDS - SENIOR CENTER - MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENTS - TATTOO/PIERCING STUDIOS

RESTAURANTS

- Restaurants may open for dine-in service - limited to 25% operating capacity including employees
- Tables at least six feet apart
- Outdoor seating areas at restaurants do not have the same 25% capacity restrictions as indoor spaces, other regulations such as spacing between tables still apply
- Condiments, silverware, flatware or glassware cannot be left on unoccupied tables
- Condiments provided upon request and in single use, non-reusable portions
- If a buffet is offered, restaurant employees must serve food to customers
- Valet services are prohibited
- Consider having all employees wear cloth face coverings
- Consider having an employee manage and control access to restaurant, including opening doors for customers

MUSEUMS & LIBRARIES

- The City of Celina Public Library will reopen on Monday, May 4, 2020
 - *Online book/media reservations are strongly encouraged*
- Must maintain at least six feet of separation from other individuals that are not from the same household
- Child's play areas will remain closed until further notice

CHURCH/PLACES OF WORSHIP/WEDDING VENUES

- Churches/Places of Worship may reopen to in-house service
- Must keep at least six (6) feet of separation between parties in any rows, except when two (2) or more members of the same household sit adjacent to one another with two empty seats on each side
- Alternate rows to be left empty
- Special arrangements for "vulnerable" attendees, including designated seating area
- Weddings, funerals, memorials and burials may now take place with the same regulations as religious services for a seated arrangement, with receptions following the regulations of restaurants

OUTDOOR SPORTS AND SWIMMING POOLS

- No more than four (4) participants at one time - no contact sports
- City of Celina tennis courts and horse shoe pit will reopen - participants must abide by social distancing rules
- Public playground equipment must remain CLOSED until further notice
- Public pools may open with restrictions on **Friday, May 8, 2020**
 - Restrictions are as follows:
 - Indoor swimming pools may operate at up to 25 percent of the total listed occupancy of the pool facility
 - Outdoor swimming pools may operate at up to 25 percent of normal operating limits as determined by the pool operator
